 ¡Seguros!	Follow instructions and use equipment safely. Tell your teacher if you feel unwell, too hot or too cold. Do not share or swap food, drinks or water bottles.

Parents and carers, por favor...

- ✓ remind your child to bring their Spanish book each week, plus a water bottle in hot weather and a coat when it is cold or rainy;
- ✓ keep contact, medical, allergy and additional needs information up to date;
- ✓ tell us as soon as possible if your child will be absent or collected by a different authorised adult; and
- ✓ use the La Jolie Ronde Media Player and our half-termly emails to support learning at home.

¡Listos! Ready

Collection routines vary between schools. Children should wait at the agreed collection point until the tutor arrives with the club flag or bell. Attendance is checked every week, and unexplained after-school absences are checked immediately with school staff.

¡Respeto! Respect

We use positive language and encourage children to listen, take turns and treat one another, equipment and their environment with kindness. Unsafe or unkind behaviour, including allergy-related teasing, will be addressed and, where necessary, discussed with the school and parents or carers.

¡Seguros! Safe

Children should follow instructions, use equipment safely and tell the tutor immediately if they feel unwell, too hot or too cold.

Food, drinks and water bottles must not be shared or swapped. Any activity involving food or potential allergens will be checked and planned in advance.

During hot or cold weather, tutors may adapt activities, provide water breaks, use shaded areas or keep activities indoors. Children may remove or add layers in line with the school's arrangements.

Supporting positive behaviour

Children will be calmly reminded of our Class Culture and may be asked to sit out of an activity if behaviour becomes unsafe or prevents others from learning. We will involve the school and parents or carers where concerns continue. Exclusion is only considered after other support has been tried.
